An Essay on Man Collage Project
Objective: to show your understanding of the complexity of human identity as Alexander Pope portrays it and to apply your knowledge to your own life
<u>Creative Task</u> : Create a collage that visually depicts—through colors, images, and words—the <u>duality</u> of human identity. In the collage illustrate the two contrasting elements of humanity as described by Pope in the excerpt from <i>An Essay on Man</i> : <u>glory</u> and <u>jest</u> (with <u>riddle</u> in the middle ground).
Written Task: Each individual will defend his or her collage in a written response by explaining the significance and meaning of the collage—including its organization, colors, images, and words—and its connection to Pope's poem. The introduction of your written response should clearly define the theme of <i>An Essay on Man</i> and each body paragraph must focus on a specific section of the collage. Your defense must incorporate quotations from the poem as evidence.
