\*Cash \*Cash (money or its equivalent; something of tangible value)

**Darl** \*<u>Darling</u> (connotes intangible attachment)

**Jewel** \*Jewel (a precious stone, of tangible value; one that is

highly esteemed)

\*<u>Jouel</u> from <u>Jou</u> (Old French for joy)

**Dewey Dell** \*Dell (valley; girl of a vagrant class)

\*<u>Dewy</u> (moist with dew; innocent and unsophisticated)

**Vardaman** \*verdant (green with growing; unripe in experience or judgment)

\*<u>Vard</u> from <u>Ward</u> (Scottish for an underage orphan)

**Anse** \*anserous (goose-like, stupid, and silly)
