


# personality types

### YELLOW strengths


dependable loyal efficient goal-driven dedicated organized realistic

- acknowledgement of earnest work



internal logical curious inventive questioning focused on learning independent as a worker forward thinking




### **GREEN strengths**

### BLUE temperament



# BLUE strengths




