# Rhythm

pattern of accent or stress in lines of verse

### Rising

- iambic
  - a metrical **foot** (unit of sound) consisting of an unaccented syllable and an accented one ("')
- anapestic

   a metrical foot consisting of three syllables, with two
   unaccented syllables followed by an accented one

### **Falling**

trochaic

(")

- a metrical foot consisting of an accented syllable and a unaccented one ('`)
- dactylic
  - a metrical foot consisting of three syllables, with an accented syllable followed by two unaccented ones ('~~)

#### **Static**

- pyrrhic
  - a metrical foot consisting of two unaccented syllables  $(\tilde{\ })$
- spondaic
   a metrical foot consisting of two accented syllables
   ('')

## measured pattern of rhythmic units

monometer one foot

dimeter two feet

trimeter three feet

tetrameter four feet

pentameter five feet

hexameter six feet

heptameter seven feet
