- 1. What is the relationship between the weight of what the soldiers carry and the burdens they carry?
- 2. What is the impact of the <u>third-person narrative</u>? Considering that this narrator is one of the soldiers, what is the significance of this character narrating in third rather than <u>first person</u>?
- 3. What is the significance of the name Jimmy Cross?
- 4. Is Jimmy Cross a dynamic character? Why or why not?
- 5. Analyze the <u>structure</u> of the story. What are the prominent divisions of the narrative focus?
- 6. How and for what purpose does the author employ a <u>motif</u> of sacrifice and savior in the story?
- 7. What phrases, images, and ideas are repeated in the story? What is the impact and significance of the <u>repetition</u>?
- 8. How does this story reveal a communal and personal experience? What is the connection and/or disconnection between the two experiences?
- 9. What is the significance of the title of the story? Consider the role of diction and syntax.
