Ballad

structure: quatrains (four-line stanzas)

- <u>meter</u>: lines 1 and 3 are iambic tetrameter lines 2 and 4 are iambic trimeter
- <u>rhyme</u>: lines 1 and 3 usually rhyme lines 2 and 4 must rhyme
- <u>topic</u>: narrative of adventure or intrigue; describes a dramatic or exciting episode; often focuses on tragedy

<u>features</u>:

- action focused on common (*not noble*) folk
- supernatural plays key role
- incremental repetition common
- often concludes with summary stanza
- originally recited or sung
