

Common Meter

structure: quatrains (four-line stanzas)

meter: lines 1 and 3 are iambic tetrameter
lines 2 and 4 are iambic trimeter

rhyme: lines 1 and 3 may rhyme
lines 2 and 4 must rhyme

example:

Appar/ently / with no / surprise	<i>A</i>
To a/ny hap/py <i>flower</i> ,	<i>B</i>
The frost / beheads / it at / its play	<i>C</i>
In ac/ciden/tal <i>power</i> .	<i>B</i>
