$\underline{\text{Level II}}: \\$ the interpretative level of analysis involving questions that require one to "read between the lines" for the answer
<u>Level III</u> : the thematic level of analysis involving questions that move beyond the text and focus on society and the human condition
Examples from <i>The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn</i> : Level I:
Who goes looking for Huck's body after he has been "murdered"?
<u>Level II</u> : Why might more people look for Huck's dead body than cared to rescue him from his abusive, drunken father?
