Ode

type:

• three forms: Pindaric (regular), Horatian, Irregular

structure:

- precise and formal
- stanza size is consistent

<u>rhyme</u>:

pattern may vary slightly with each stanza

meter:

• iambic but with varying line lengths

topic:

- focused on serious topics, such as truth, art, freedom, justice, or the meaning of life
- intense expression of an elevated thought, often addressed to a praised person or object
- elaborate, dignified, and imaginative
